1. Recognition of Emergencies (20 pts)

Student should verbally identify at least 3 emergency signs (e.g., heatstroke, bleeding, respiratory distress). Instructor should confirm student can distinguish between minor and life-threatening conditions using real or scenario-based examples.

2. Triage Skills (15 pts)

Student must correctly categorize at least 3 scenarios into urgency levels. Instructor should assess whether student prioritizes life-threatening cases first and understands when immediate veterinary care is required.

3. Handling and Restraint (15 pts)

Student demonstrates safe approach, proper positioning, and restraint techniques. Instructor should observe body positioning, avoidance of face-to-face contact, and correct use of towel or muzzle techniques.

4. Wound Care (10 pts)

Student demonstrates how to control bleeding and clean a wound. Instructor should confirm correct use of pressure, appropriate materials, and avoidance of improper substances.

5. Heatstroke Recognition (10 pts)

Student identifies signs such as panting, collapse, red gums. Instructor should confirm correct explanation of response steps including stopping grooming and initiating cooling.

6. CPR & Choking Knowledge (10 pts)

Student explains steps of CPR and choking response. Instructor should verify correct sequence and understanding of when CPR is appropriate.

7. Legal Awareness (10 pts)

Student explains limitations (no meds, need owner consent). Instructor should confirm student understands role boundaries and escalation procedures.

8. Preparedness (10 pts)

Student lists required first aid kit items and emergency contacts. Instructor should confirm understanding of salon protocols and documentation.
